



FLANGE BINDING

Cut enough 1 1/2" strips so that when sewn together end to end you will have enough to go around the entire outside of your quilt, plus about 15". This will be your binding color. Cut enough 1 3/4" strips to make the same length. Sew end to end. This will be your Flange or accent color.



Place both strips right sides together and sew an 1/4" seam the entire length of the strips. Press towards the 1 1/2" strip.



Align raw edges and press entire strip in half length wise. The back of the binding will be your accent fabric. The front will be your binding fabric with a small strip of the accent color exposed.



Place binding strip front side down on BACK of quilt, with raw edges aligned. Sew binding on with 1/4" seam as you would normally. Fold binding to front. Pin and machine sew in ditch where accent meets binding. Miter corners.
