

French Seam Instructions (AKA enclosed seams)

Used frequently to finished seams for such things as pillow cases without the use of a serger.

1. Pieces of fabric WRONG sides together.
2. Stitch width should be 1/8" to 1/4".
3. Turn fabric inside out, so RIGHT sides are together.
4. Press seam. (Maybe pressed before turning - but do not press seam open).
5. Now stitch seam 1/4" to 3/8" from edge, (the seam will now be enclosed).
6. Turn fabric inside out, so Right sides are facing out.

Walla, your seam is enclosed.
