There will be a total solar eclipse in April, 2024. The map above shows bands where viewers will see the total eclipse. Other areas outside the band will see at least a partial eclipse. It is unsafe to view even a partial solar eclipse without specialized viewing filters. NASA would like to educate the public prior to the eclipse, so CPQG will be collaborating with Sentara Regional Medical Center to exhibit quilts that convey the beauty of the eclipse and how to observe it safely. REGULAR SUNGLASSES DO NOT WORK!

SUBMISSION DEADLINE:


