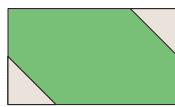
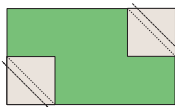
Cutting Directions



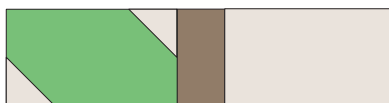
Block Assembly



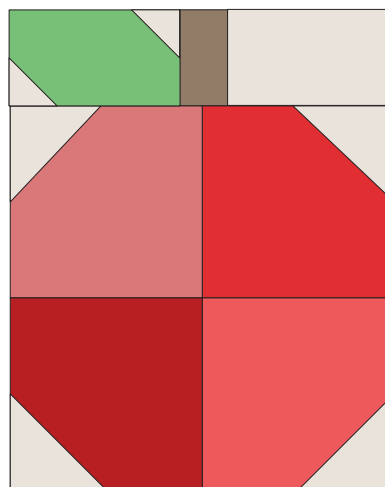
Draw a diagonal line on the back of the 2 1/2" squares. Place in the corner of a red square and sew along the drawn line. Trim 1/4" from the seam and press seams toward the red fabric. Make 4.



Draw a diagonal line on the back of the 1 1/2" squares. Sew one to the top right corner and one to the bottom left corner. Sew on the drawn line and trim 1/4" from the seam. Press toward green fabric.



Assemble the block as shown in the diagram on the left. Your finished block should measure 10 1/2" x 8 1/2".



Finishing

For your convenience here are the measurements of the sashing and borders I used in my quilt. (cut dimensions)

Horizontal sashing: 2 1/2"

Vertical sashing: 4 1/2"

Inner Border: 4 1/2"

Outer Border: 4 1/2" red squares (does not finish exactly on the square)
