Materials

Accent Squares	(25) 2.5in colored squares
**Use whatever color way you	OR
would like!	(2 – 3) 35in X 2.5in colored strips
Sashing	(20) 1 in X 2.5 in
	(4) 1 in X 12.5in
** Use black and white	OR
	(3) WOF X 1in strips (used for both vertical and horizontal)

Instructions

Use 1/4in seam allowance unless stated otherwise

- 1. Take 20 of the accent squares and sew a piece of sashing to one of the sides. Press the seam towards the accent.
 - a. Alternative: Instead of using squares, you can use something like a jelly roll (2.5in strip). Sew the 1in sashing down the entire length of the jelly roll. Press towards the accent, and then subcut into 2.5in. Continue the written.
- 2. Pair up the accent/sashing so that the new piece is attached
- instructions as they are







- to the opposite side of the already attached sashing. Press the seam towards the accent.
- 3. Repeat one more time until you have an alternating row of accent and sashing, ending with a single sashing side. Take one of the remaining 5 accent squares and add to the empty sashing. Press the seam towards the accent.
- 4. Once you have five rows of accent/sashing, line up one of the 12.5in sashing (pin as needed) and sew together. Press to the sashing.
- 5. Add the next row of accent (pinning becomes more important here to make sure the vertical sashing line up). Press towards the sashing.
- 6. Repeat until you have a gride of 5 by 5.
