

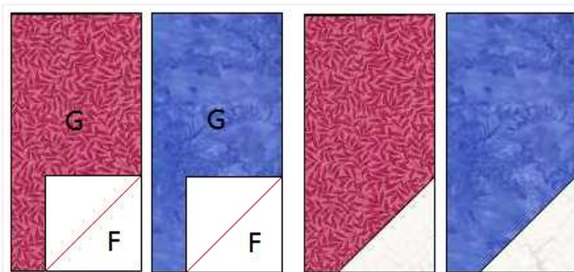
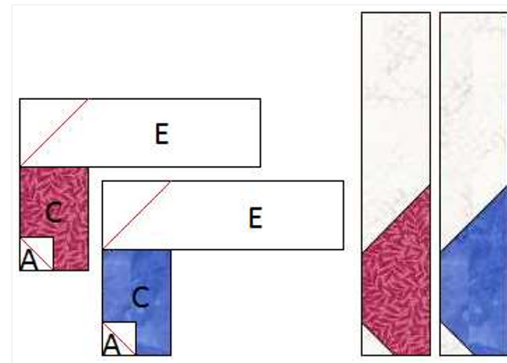

Background: White on white	A – (2) 1.5in squares D – (2) 2.5in X 6.5in	E – (2) 2.5in X 7.5in F – (2) 3.5in Squares
Sock #1 (needs a dark and a light color)	Dark C – (1) 2.5in X 5.5in G – (1) 4.5in X 8.5in	Light B – (1) 2.5in X 4.5in
Sock #2 Needs a dark and a light color	Dark C – (1) 2.5in X 5.5in G – (1) 4.5in X 8.5in	Light B – (1) 2.5in X 4.5in

STOP Method: Stitch, Trim, Open, and Press.

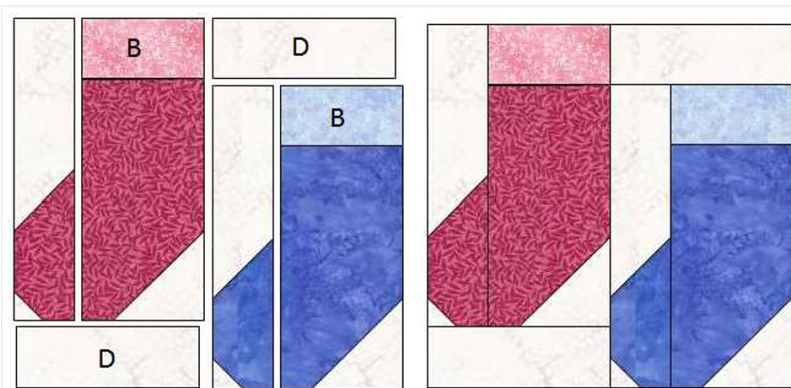
To perform the STOP method, align a square or rectangle on the corner of the unit with right sides facing together. Draw a diagonal line and sew along this diagonal line. Trim a 1/4in seam. Finger press the seam open and the press with a hot iron. Pressing the seams open to reduce bulk is recommended.

Directions

1. Use the STOP method to add the Background (A) square and (E) rectangle on the Sock 1 & 2 Dark (C) rectangle.



2. Use the STOP method to add the Background (F) squares on the corners of the Socks 1 & 2 Dark (G) rectangles.



3. Along with the Background (D) and Socks 1 & 2 Light (B) rectangles, arrange and sew the units together to complete the block. Block should measure 1.25in square.
